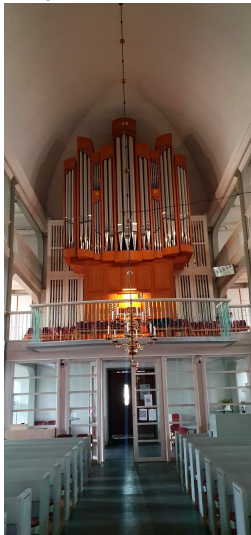

Description

The organ was constructed by Orgelbau Mühleisen, a company based in Leonberg, in 2006. The predecessor of this organ was made by Kemper in 1961, consisting of three manuals and pedal with 38 stops, and was later sold to Poland.
