Description

The organ was constructed by Lothar E. Banzhaf in Husum in 1998 and was inaugurated on February 1, 1998. The first organ in the church of St. Marien was built by Marcussen & Søn in 1871. In 1998, the organ was rebuilt by Lothar E. Banzhaf, which included the adaptation of four registers from the Marcussen Organ. In 2012, the 'Fagott 16' was substituted with a 'Trompete 8.' The casing is massive, built with French oak using a frame construction with fillings.
