Description

The organ was constructed by Alfred Führer in Wilhelmshaven in 1971. In 2015, it was renovated and slightly expanded by Hinrich Otto Paschen in Kiel. In addition to this, the swell chest (Brustwerk) was made movable and a new console was installed.
