### Description

The organ was constructed by Marcussen & Søn in 1875. There were reconfigurations and expansions from the original 26 to 35 registers conducted by the organ-building company Tolle in 1935, 1960, and 1980. During the last remodeling in 1980, the coupling manual was also installed.
