## Description

The organ front with two trumpet angels dates from 1754 and was created by Johann Caspar Beck. The wooden pipes are intended to imitate metal in color.

A new organ was built inside in 2004 by the Orgelbau Kutter company in Friedrichroda, which is intended to represent a mixture of historical and modern elements.
