## Description

The builder of the organ is currently unknown. However, based on its style, it resembles the organs built by F. Weissenborn and E. Schulze, especially the Gamba 8' pipes. The Zimbelstern has the notes C, D, E, G (inscription – A Cs G Ds) with a bell marked "1880, Zavoda Ovechkina, Purekh, Nizheguberniye" (in Cyrillic).
