Description

The organ, as indicated by the date found on its prospect, was built in 1862. Currently, there is no detailed information about the instrument's builder. One notable feature of the organ is the manual wind chest valves with pre-valves, which is considered rare.

The organ was constructed with high-quality materials but has suffered primarily from poor maintenance. With thorough research and professional restoration, the instrument has the potential to be an excellent example of classical organ building.
