Description

The inscription "Reval 1900" on the largest Bourdon 16' pipe indicates that the organ was built in 1900 for Tallinn. Currently, there is no detailed information on how and when the organ was relocated to Strenči Church.

The instrument remains in nearly original condition, including its pipes, preserving its historical integrity and offering a glimpse into the craftsmanship of the early 20th century.
